TEA PLANTATION IN ASSAM :-

1.1 ① INTRODUCTION:

The state of Assam is the world's largest tea growing region, lying on either side of the Brahmaputra River, and bordering Bangladesh and Myanmar. This part of India experiences high precipitation; during the monsoon period, as much as 10 to 12 inches (250 - 300 mm) of rain per day. The daytime temperature rises to about 103 F (40°C); creating greenhouse-like conditions of extreme humidity and heat. This tropical climate contributes to Assam's a feature which the tea well known.
